Charlie said he knows this is a problem and they were going to get it cut down but nothing has happened so far. I'm a bit concerned with all the storms recently. It may come down on its own but more which direction it will fall as my horses are literally right next to it.

I was wondering if there was anything that can be done to safeguard this happening? Or who I need to speak to.

I have video of the tree and how it's moving at the bottom if that helps, or can get any pictures of what you would need.
